As seniors come to the end of our 7-year strategy, it is essential that we help them develop a plan for what comes next. For a student who has spent all 7 years in our student ministry, they have been well equipped with the knowledge and the resources necessary to be ready to walk out the doors and take on the world. That's the point of our strategy.

But we also know that having a clear plan in place for *how* they will implement that strategy is of equal importance. And the best way to build that plan is with and alongside each senior. This is why, every spring semester, our seniors will come together and, as a group, decide on and build The Game Plan. We will work through 10 principles, identifying and writing down action steps for each one of them. As our seniors collaborate together, they will be pulling from the years of training they have received in order to develop their game plan.

As part of our Building Blocks strategy here at SMRBC, we celebrate our graduates at a Celebration Dinner each spring semester. Part of their gift will actually be a booklet called "The Game Plan", and it will have been written by them! But we all know that a plan is best pursued when there is accountability present. That is why we encourage each of our seniors to not only celebrate along with their families at our Celebration Dinner, but to invite three other people to join them as accountability partners: A friend, a senior adult, and a mentor. The goal behind this is that our seniors will present their game plan to the people they've entrusted it to and ask them to help keep them accountable.

We believe this is a great way to cap off their 7 years in student ministry! We pray that as each student graduates and heads out on their own, that due to our 7 Year Strategy & The Game Plan, they will be rooted in truth, ready to reach in love, and have their people who they can lean on and trust to keep them faithful.
